ST. SIMEON THE GOD-RECEIVER AND THE PROPHETESS ANNA

EPISTLE READING: This morning's Apostolic reading is from St. Paul's second letter to the Corinthians, Chapter 6, Verses 1-10. It is found in our books, on pages 114-115.

Here, the Orthodox Christian faith is poised to proclaim the Gospel message of salvation to a whole new generation of worshipers!
