THIRD SUNDAY OF THE GREAT LENT: VENERATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

EPISTLE READING: This morning's Apostolic reading is from St. Paul's first letter to the Hebrews, Chapter 4, Verse 14 - Chapter 5, Verse 6. It is found in our books on pages 142-143.

PARKING: We have signed a 6-month trial agreement with Golden State Parking so that, as soon as it obtains the necessary permits, it can operate our parking component. All permits but one have been obtained. We anticipate the permit by the fire department will be obtained as soon as the fire sprinklers and the hydrant have become operational, hopefully this week. Meanwhile, we've signed a contract with Albert Electric, to finalize the electrical work, finish the lobbies and install the necessary doors. However, we will need to install the final gates in order to satisfy the "clear path of travel" requirements, which includes the final inspection of the elevator.
