EPISTLE READING OF THE DAY: This morning's Apostolic Reading is from Saint Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, Chapter 1, Verses 10-17. It is found in our books on page 102.

**SPECIAL AUGUST SERVICES:** As we prepare for the Feast of the Dormition on August 15, the service of *Paraklesis* will be offered tomorrow, Monday, August 12, beginning at 7 pm. On the Feast of the Dormition, August 15, Orthros will be celebrated at 9 am, followed by the Divine Liturgy, at 10 am. Following the Divine Liturgy, a luncheon will take place, in our Korinthias Hall. For your convenience, valet parking in our lot will be available.

**ADOPT A PAVER:** The most recent issue of the *Herald* said something about "Adopt a Paver." It's quite simple. For a gift of \$2,000.00 to the Building Fund, parishioners and friends of the Cathedral may have their name(s) inscribed in one of the courtyard pavers. PARKING: We're slowly getting there. This week, we ordered the Valencia Street gates and the installation of the granite along the lower walls. This will allow for the completion of the pavers along the walkway. Meanwhile, we are completing the elevator lobbies, with a view to getting final inspection on our elevator. We have also completed the requirements for the Fire Department. This should enable us, at long last, to receive our occupancy permit for the parking component, so that we may formally engage Golden State Parking to run it. Meanwhile, we're about to launch our "Adopt a Paver" program, affording parishioners and friends to inscribe their name(s) on one of 750 courtyard pavers. We are moving ahead. As we go forward, let's stay positive and focused. Consider what you have accomplished so far! As with Moses, then, in our day we hear God speaking to us: "Build me a Sanctuary, and I will appear among you." (from the Septuagint: Καὶ ποιήσεις μοι άγίασμα, καὶ ὀφθήσομαι ἐν ὑμῖν). (Exodus 25:8). Building also takes vision, determination and faith. You are doing something extraordinary: you are building His sanctuary, a great sacred space, right the heart of one of the world's premier cities. Here, our Orthodox Christian faith is poised to proclaim the Gospel message of salvation to a whole new generation of worshipers!
