

Community Kitchen

The crowds are growing and so is our volunteer base! Thank you to everyone who helped us in September for a record breaking service! We appreciated being able to share the kitchen with festival prep and we made it work, grateful to our church community for helping us out! We served over 120 meals to folks and are prepping next month for even more! We're Back In Hot Water

Not exactly... but we'd like to let you know that a new gas boiler was installed in September prior to the food festival weekend. Our facility has two gas boilers, one providing hot water for heating the building and one providing hot, potable water for our commercial kitchen and all the hot water faucets. The new boiler is for the latter purpose and replaces the boiler installed when the community center was built. The boiler, a high-efficiency 500 MBH Laars Mighty Therm2 unit (model number MT2H0500), was installed by Bay City Boiler. This, along with the building heat boiler installed in early 2023, should serve the needs of our community for decades to come.

Exciting Updates for Our Elpida Program

After much prayerful consideration, numerous meetings with the Elpida board, and thoughtful collaboration with both our clergy and parish council, we're excited to announce a new chapter for the Elpida Program! These changes reflect our commitment to strengthening our community and addressing the practical challenges we've faced over the years.

Introducing Elpida Families!

In this new format, children will be placed into mixed-age "Elpida Families," allowing younger and older students to connect, learn from one another, and build a sense of belonging. No child will ever feel left out, even in smaller class sizes. This new structure also simplifies scheduling, making it easier for everyone to participate, especially when our teachers aren't always available.

Classes will now be held once a

month after Holy Communion and will last about an hour. We encourage every child to attend! Father Angelo has made it clear that Elpida attendance is a requirement for children participating in ministries like Greek dance, sports, GOYA, JR GOYA and HOPE.. It's important for our children to stay engaged in their faith so they can proudly represent Annunciation in their activities.

We've worked hard to restructure the program, but we can't succeed without you. Please make Elpida a priority for your family.
